

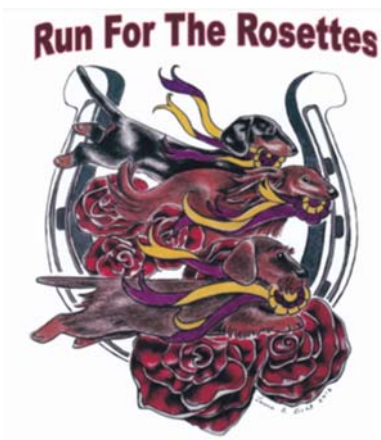

## Directions to The Crowne Plaza Hotel

**From the North:** I-65 S, cross from IN into KY over toll bridge. Go approximately 7 miles and take Exit 131B onto the Watterson Expressway Airport/Fair/Expo Center. Use the right lane to follow signs toward Fair/Expo Center. At the stoplight, turn left onto Phillips Lane. Hotel is immediately on the left.

**From the South:** I-65 N, take Exit 131B onto the Watterson Expressway Airport/Fair/Expo Center. Use the right lane to follow signs toward Fair/Expo Center. At the stoplight, turn left onto Phillips Lane. Hotel is immediately on the left.

**From the East:** I-64 W, use the second to the right lane to take Exit 12 onto I-264 W/Watterson Expressway, stay left at the fork toward the Airport. Go 6.9 miles to take Exit 11 Crittenden Drive/Airport/Fair/Expo Center. Use the right lane to follow signs to Fair/Expo Center Main Gate. At the stoplight, turn left onto Phillips Lane. Hotel is immediately on the left.

**From the West:** I-64 E, as you near Louisville, use the left lane to take the I-65 S exit. Go 5.5 miles and take Exit 131B onto the Watterson Expressway Airport/Fair/Expo Center. Use the right lane to follow signs toward Fair/Expo Center. At the stoplight, turn left onto Phillips Lane. Hotel is immediately on the left.

**From Cincinnati:** Take I-71 S toward Louisville. Use the left lane to take Exit 5 onto I-264/Watterson Expressway. Go 11 miles and take Exit 11 Crittenden Drive/Airport/Fair/Expo Center. Use the right lane to follow signs to Fair/Expo Center Main Gate. At the stoplight, turn left onto Phillips Lane. Hotel is immediately on the left.

At stoplight, go straight .6 mile. At stoplight turn right onto Preston Hwy/Hwy 61, go .2 mile. Turn left onto Belmar Dr., go .6 mile. Continue straight onto Reservoir Ave, go .2 mile. Turn left onto Taylor Ave, go .6 mile. Turn right onto Poplar Level Road, go 300 feet and Hospital is on the right.

**24 Hour Animal Emergency Clinic:** Metropolitan Veterinary Specialists and Emergency Services, 11800 Capital Way, Louisville 40297, 502-266-7007, 14 miles, 17 minutes depending on traffic. **Directions:** From the hotel, turn right onto Phillips Lane. At the stoplight, turn right and then keep left to take the ramp to I-264/Watterson Expressway East. Watch the signs as you pass the airport to continue onto I-264 E/Watterson. You will continue to merge left as you travel I-264. Continue on I-264 East approximately 8 miles to take Exit 19A to the right onto I-64 East. Go 4.6 miles to Exit 17, Blankenbaker Parkway. Keep right at the fork to take South Blankenbaker. Merge onto Blankenbaker for .9 mile. Turn left onto Capital Way. Go 250 feet, clinic is on the right.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

Class Cash Prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent advised at once. The Superintendent and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

## **Non-Regular (Additional) Classes Involving Single Dog Entries (National Specialty Only)**

**Winners of these Classes are eligible to compete in Best of Variety if undefeated in any other class Veteran Classes.** Open to dogs and bitches 7 years and older; neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in **Competitive Veterans Classes** at independent specialties.

**Veteran classes divided as follows: 7-under 9 years; 9-under 11 years; 11 years and older**  
**Field Trial.** Open to dogs or bitches that have placed in an AKC sanctioned or licensed field trial.  
**Dual Champion.** Open to dogs and bitches that have earned both an AKC Show Championship as well as an AKC Field Trial Championship. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in the Dual Champion Class.

## **Non-Regular Classes (Additional) Involving Multiple Dog Entries (National Specialty Only)**

*In accordance with AKC rule Ch 11, Sec 8, a neutered dog may be entered as the Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as the Brood Bitch in a Brood Bitch class.*

*As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.*

**Stud Dog Class. (National Only)** For stud dogs and at least two and no more than four of their get. Stud dog must be entered in the appropriate Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with its get. Owner of stud dog need not necessarily be owner of get. Get only to be judged, based upon their merits. While the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Variety Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class.

**Brood Bitch Class. (National Only)** Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

- \*ILP dogs are eligible to compete and can earn a Certificate of Achievement, but are not eligible for Triathlon Dog of the Year.

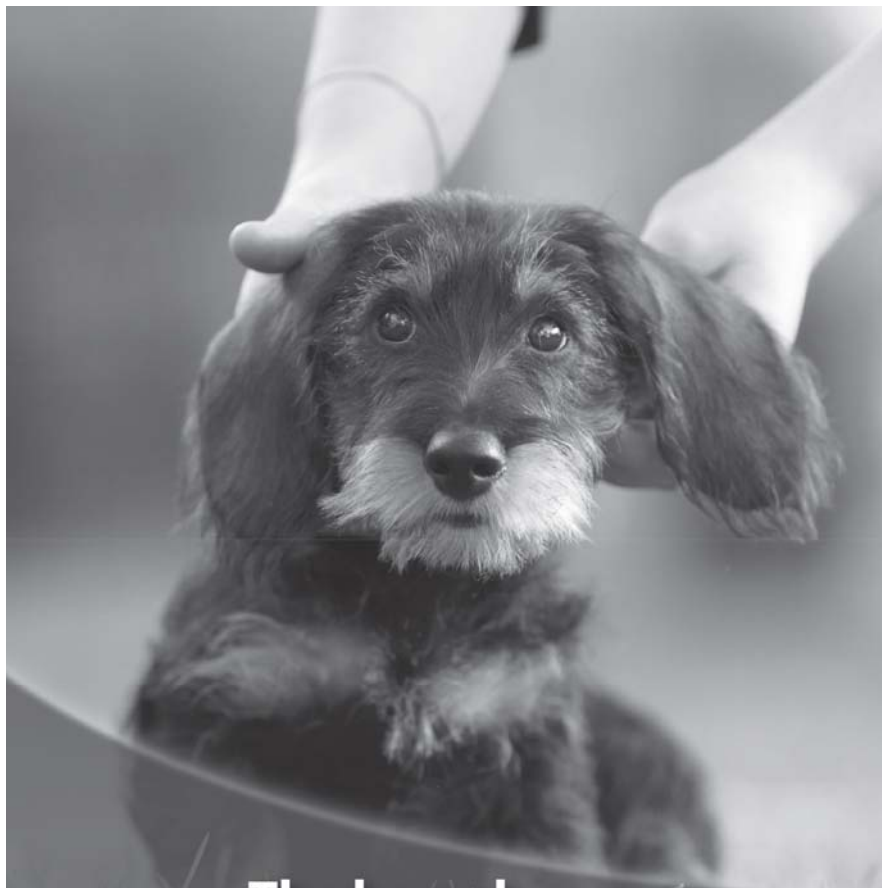
