The entries in Regular, Preferred, and Optional Titling classes are counted in the determination of awards.

If an obedience trial is held as a designated part of an all-breed event, only the **dachshund** entries in Regular, Preferred, and Optional Titling classes are counted in the determination of awards.

If a dog competes in more than one class, only the highest score achieved by each dog will be considered so that the same dog cannot be awarded both the Highest Scoring Dog and the Second Highest Scoring Dog

Rally Obedience is excluded from the entry counts in the determination of awards.
