DIRECTIONS: Flint River Beagle Club, 982 Babbs Mill Rd, Hampton, Ga 30228

The grounds are south of Atlanta off of Interstate 75. From Atlanta, take I-75 south to Exit 221, Jonesboro Rd. Take Jonesboro road west toward Lovejoy. Travel approximately 5 miles and turn left on Babbs Mill Road. Travel approximately 2 miles to the grounds at 982 Babbs Mill Road.

From Macon, Ga, take I-75 north to Exit 218, Ga 20W/ Ga 81W, toward McDonough/ Hampton. Go left and then take an immediate right onto Ga-81. Travel 6 miles and turn right onto Mt. Carmel Rd. Take the first left onto Conkle Rd, then the first right onto Babbs Mill Road for a short distance to the grounds.

PLEASE NOTE: The grounds will be available for set up at 12:00 PM, March 30, and all set-ups must be removed by 6PM April 2nd, unless prior arrangements are made. Please keep your set-up clean. All trash must be bagged and tied to allow for easy removal from the grounds. The gate to exit the grounds is not closed and there is a busy road outside the parking lot. Dogs cannot be loose in the parking lot and x-pens must be securely anchored. There is a clubhouse on the grounds with restroom facilities and a shower. Roll call and meals will be held in the clubhouse. Please help us to keep the clubhouse clean by picking up after meals and while using the facilities. Poop bags should be discarded in trash cans and not left in the field or parking lot. There will be a \$25 fee for each adult rabbit killed or injured.

**ENTRY FEE:** \$25.00 per entry for regular classes all days. See above description for CVDC Veterans Class entry fees. **Make checks payable to: CVDC-DCA 2015.** Be sure to bring your dogs' entry information with you. Dogs must be present on the grounds at the time entries close to be officially entered. Owner is responsible for correct information on the entry forms. Please note the divided FC classes and make proper notation on the entry form for the specific class. You may copy the enclosed form if you need more forms.

RUNNING ORDER: The size of the entry and field /weather conditions will dictate whether classes are run consecutively or concurrently. The potential class running order for both events are specified above. The committee may make changes to the running order as needed to expedite the event. The DCA Field Trial will begin immediately after the conclusion of the CVDC Field Trial. \*\*\* In order to insure completion and to expedite both events, it is critical that all participants contribute in the field as beaters as needed. \*\*\*

**DRESS:** It is recommended that sturdy shoes or boots and durable clothing be worn. Bring appropriate gear as the trial will be run rain or shine.
