10 to 29 entries 5" Bronze Plaque, in coat of winner, for High in Trial and

Sunburst Medallion for 2nd High in Trial

30 or more entries 8" Bronze Plaque, in coat of winner, for High in Trial and

5" Bronze Plaque, in coat of winner, for 2nd High in Trial

THE DACHSHUND CLUB OF AMERICA INC further offers a Gold- Plated Dachshund pin for each Dachshund attaining a Qualifying Score in Regular, Preferred, and Optional Titling Classes. No minimum number of entries required.

The entries in Regular, Preferred, and Optional Titling classes are counted in the determination of awards.

If an obedience trial is held as a designated part of an all-breed event, only the **dachshund** entries in Regular, Preferred, and Optional Titling classes are counted in the determination of awards.

If a dog competes in more than one class, only the highest score achieved by the dog will be considered so that the same dog cannot be awarded both the Highest Scoring Dog and the Second Highest Scoring Dog in regular classes.

Rally Obedience is excluded from the entry counts in the determination of awards.
