## SHOW REGULATIONS

**For the DCA National Earthdog Test only: Dachshund entries will run first in all classes. In Master Earthdog, dachshunds will be braced with dachshunds followed by braces of all other eligible breeds.**

**\*THE FOLLOWING BREEDS ARE CLASSIFIED AS ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE AKC EARTHDOG TESTS: DACHSHUNDS and the following TERRIER BREEDS: Australian, American Hairless, Belington, Border, Cairn, Cesky, Dandie Dinmont, Fox (Smooth and Wire), Glen of Imaal, Jagdterrier, Lakeland, Manchester, Miniature Bull, Miniature Pinchers, Miniature Schnauzers, Norfolk, Norwich, Parson Russell, Rat, Russell, Scottish, Sealyham, Silky, Skye, Welsh, West Highland White, & Yorkshire.**

**ELIGIBILITY:** Dogs must be at least 6 months old. Dogs that are spayed or neutered or have a Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative (ILP or PAL) number may participate. A dog of an eligible breed with an acceptable foreign registration number is eligible to participate.

**MULTIPLE ENTRIES:** Dogs may enter more than one regular class at an earthdog test provided the dog is eligible for the class as defined in AKC regulations for Earthdog Tests, Chapter 3.

Afternoon classes will be tied to the morning classes as follows:

1. Entries for the afternoon classes will to close 30 min after the completion of the last class of the morning. Closing time for each class will follow the same pattern and order as morning classes.
2. All classes will begin no sooner than 15 minutes following the closing time for each.

### Classes offered

- **Introduction to Quarry (Intro)** – Non-regular class. Open to all dogs 6 months or older.
- **Junior Earthdog** – Open to all eligible breeds of dogs. Dogs that have earned a Junior Earthdog title may continue to enter but may not receive another certificate.
- **Senior Earthdog-** Open to dogs that have acquired the Junior Earthdog title and to dogs that have been recorded by the AKC as Senior Earthdogs and/or Master Earthdogs.
- **Master Earthdog-** Open to dogs that have earned a Senior Earthdog title.

### THE ENDURANCE EARTHDOG TITLE

In order to be eligible to earn an Endurance Earthdog (EE) title, a dog must have already earned a Master Earthdog title. An Endurance Earthdog title is earned when a dog on five occasions passes both the Senior and Master classes at the same event (one event number). The owner shall record each of the five Double Qualification on a form provided by AKC. Once five Double Qualifications have been awarded, the completed form is submitted to AKC along with a title recording fee of \$30.00. Upon verification, a title will be issued to the owner and the dog shall be identified as an Endurance Earthdog by the suffix Title EE.

If handlers have a conflict and so inform the gate steward, every effort will be made to accommodate them.

**DOGS MUST BE AT LEAST 6 MONTHS OLD.** AKC registered dogs, dogs with ILP or PAL numbers of eligible breeds that are spayed or neutered or have a Limited Registration may participate. Only completed entry forms, including Registration, ILP or PAL numbers will be accepted.

**BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY.** Pre-entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until closing time of the class. After a class closes, entry fees will not be refunded.

**NO DOG** shall be allowed inside the test area until his or her judging time OR within 100 feet of test areas while classes are being run.

**EXCESSIVE BARKING** will result in exhibitors being asked to quiet their dogs. Repeated requests to control barking may result in the exhibitor being asked to leave the grounds.

**NO FLEXI-LEADS PERMITTED** in or around the dens.

**ALL DOGS** are to be on leash or confined to exercise pens while on the test grounds. Please be considerate of others when setting up ex-pens. Space should be condensed as much as possible. No Dog are to be left unattended in ex-pens
