- ▶ **Dogs must be at least 6 months old.** AKC registered dogs, dogs with ILP or PAL numbers of eligible breeds that are spayed or neutered, or have a Limited Registration may participate. Only completed entry forms, including Registration, ILP or PAL numbers will be accepted.
- ▶ **Bitches in season are not eligible for entry.** Entry fees paid for a bitch that comes into season will not be refunded.
- ▶ **Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.** The Test Secretary shall add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
- ▶ **Entry fees will not be refunded** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified or excused by the judge or veterinarian, or barred by the Test Committee. No entry fees will be returned if the test cannot start or be completed due to an act of God or any cause beyond control of the Test Committee.
- ▶ **The owner or handler entering a dog in these tests does so at his or her own risk** and agrees to assume responsibility for any damage caused by him/her or by his/her dog. He/she also agrees to abide by all rules set forth in this premium list.
- ▶ **No dogs shall be allowed within 100 feet of test areas** while classes are being run.
- ▶ **Excessive barking** will result in exhibitors being asked to quiet their dogs. Repeated requests to control barking may result in the exhibitor being asked to leave the grounds.
- ▶ **No dog will be allowed inside the test area** until his or her judging time.
- ▶ **Spectators shall be allowed outside the test area** provided that they are quiet and do not distract the dogs.
- ▶ **All dogs are to be on leash or confined to exercise pens** while on the test grounds. Please be considerate of others when setting up ex-pens. Space should be condensed as much as possible. You may be asked to reduce the number or size of your pens.
- ▶ **Bring water, shade and shelter** for you and your dogs. These tests will be run rain or shine.

Directions from the Field Trial Site

Take Hartman Rd to Rte 29 and turn right. At Rte 11, turn left and after 1.1 miles take Rte 29 towards the right to Rte 11 for 5.3 miles to I-81. Take I-81 South to I-80 West. I-80 West to exit 161 US220 towards I-99/Belafonte. Take I-99 south to the PA Turnpike West and follow directions from either the East or the West below.

Directions from the West:

Take the PA Turnpike to Exit #91, Donegal. Turn left at the exit onto Rt. 31 East, drive for approximately 1 mile. Make a right onto Mountain View Road. Go to the T intersection. Turn left onto Mt. Olive Road. As you start down the hill, test site is on the left. Turn into the gravel driveway by the barn with the red roof. Park in the field that is uphill from the barn.

Directions from the East if staying at a Somerset hotel:

Take the PA Turnpike to Exit # 110, Somerset. Go to the second light and turn right (Harley Davidson) onto Rt. 601. Go to top of hill and turn right onto Main St - Rt. 31W. Follow Rt. 31 for approximately 17 miles. After passing a flashing light, look for the American Legion on the left. Turn left onto Mountain View Road. Go to the T intersection. Turn left onto Mt. Olive Rd. As you start down the hill, test site is on the left. Turn into the gravel driveway by the barn with the red roof. Park in the field on the left that is uphill from the barn.
