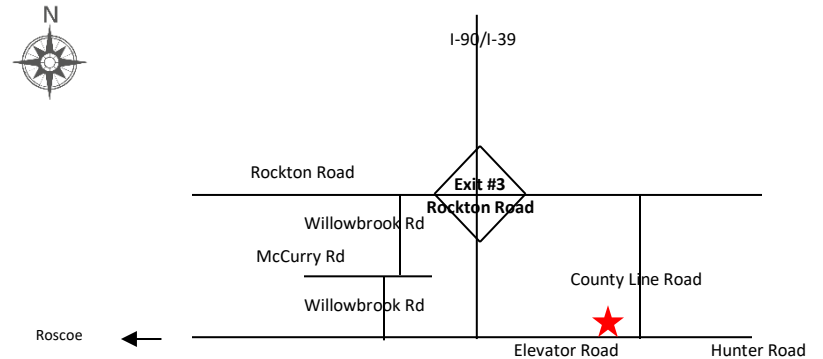

From I-39 /I-90, go to Rockton Road (Exit #3). Go East on Rockton Road to County Line Road (second stop sign). Take County Line Road South to Elevator Road. Go West on Elevator Road .3 miles. NIBC will be on the North side of Elevator Road.

From I-43 go to Highway 140 (Exit #6). Go South on Highway 140. After about 5 miles Highway 140 curves at the State Line and becomes Highway 76. Continue for 4.5 miles to Hunter Road. Take Hunter Road to the West (right) for about 6 miles to NIBC on the North side of Elevator Road (Hunter Road becomes Elevator Road at the County Line .3 miles before NIBC).

RULES AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

ABSOLUTE. “The running procedure for Absolute shall be at the discretion of the field trial committee and shall be specified in the premium list.” DCA Board of Directors, October 14, 2017

Procedure for April 20-24 trials: Absolute is a competition, not a stake or “non-regular” class. Absolute will be held immediately following the conclusion of all regular stakes, if possible. If it is not possible to hold the competition as scheduled, the field trial committee shall announce and post when/if the competition will take place. The FIRST place winners of each regular stake are eligible for Absolute unless they are ineligible to compete under the actual judges. Bitches that are in season, as determined by the field trial committee, are ineligible to compete against any males. Participation in Absolute shall be voluntary, not mandatory. All handlers of dogs eligible to compete for Absolute must keep themselves informed of the progress, conclusion and location of the final stake of the trial and be available when called for, or they shall be deemed to have voluntarily withdrawn. Two qualified judges shall be selected in accordance with AKC rules and procedures on the day of the Absolute run. To determine the Absolute Winner, Brace 1 shall be Open Dog Winner vs. Open Bitch Winner, followed by Brace 2, which shall be FC Dog Winner vs. FC Bitch Winner. Winners of Brace 1 and Brace 2 shall compete for Absolute Winner. If a brace is incomplete, or becomes incomplete, the remaining dog may continue to compete. Absolute may be withheld for lack of merit, but not for lack of competition.

APPRENTICES. Opportunities to apprentice will be made available at other trials, but are not available for the National and Host Club trials.

BEATING BRUSH. Everyone needs to contribute to the success of the trials in some way. Beating brush is an essential part of field trialing, and the trial cannot be conducted without brush beaters. If you are unable to beat brush, please find another way to contribute! There are numerous clubhouse chores that need attention for those unable to be in the field.

CAMPING. Overnight camping is available at the grounds with a reservation.

Reservations are required by Wednesday April 10. **Payment must be made upon arrival.** Checks for camping should be made to NORTHERN ILLINOIS BRACE CLUB (NIBC). The CAMPING RESERVATION REQUEST FORM is in the premium list. Please note that clubhouse “camping” is not available for these trials.

Camping spaces will be assigned upon arrival. Spaces may not be shared, exchanged or otherwise changed without permission. SEE STAN KNOLL UPON ARRIVAL.

EARLY ARRIVAL AND LATE DEPARTURES are possible, but must be arranged in advance with Cheri Faust.

CLUBHOUSE. No dogs allowed in the clubhouse except for awards. Washing dog dishes in the kitchen sink of the clubhouse is not allowed – please use the outdoor sink (preferred) or the bathroom sink, if necessary. A shower is available in the

clubhouse and will be available from after the conclusion of awards until 7:00 a.m. each day. Bring your own towels.

DOGS WAITING IN THE FIELD. Dogs on carts, dogs crated in the field or otherwise waiting to run must be kept QUIET and not be a distraction. Carts with dogs not under control will be asked to move or leave the field. Tethering of dogs to the fence is NOT allowed.

ENTRIES. Pre-entry will not be accepted for these trials. Entry forms must be complete, legible and submitted on a regulation 5 ½” x 8 ½” form. A separate entry form must be submitted for each dog for each trial entered.

Any bank fees incurred, in addition to the actual amount of the check, will be assessed for returned checks.

FIELD MARSHALS. Sherry Ruggieri will coordinate field marshals and serve as Chief Marshal. If you are willing to marshal, please let Sherry Ruggieri know what stake(s) will work for you. Marshals will be confirmed day-of-trial.

FOOD. Breakfast and Lunch will be available at the trials. **Breakfast \$7 – Lunch \$10. One beverage included with lunch.** Advance reservations are not required. If you have special needs/diet requirements, please plan accordingly. If you prepare evening meals in the clubhouse, PLEASE bring your own paper goods (paper towels, paper plates, plastic ware, etc.). You MUST clean up and PUT AWAY after yourself. Do not leave leftovers in the refrigerators – they will be disposed of without notice! Please don’t take, borrow, use or serve food that you did not bring. No refrigerator space will be available in the clubhouse, except for medications which should be clearly marked with the owner’s name.

HARNESSES. The AKC rules are silent regarding the use of body harnesses. As a result, body harnesses will only be allowed if the handler receives advance permission of both judges for the stake. By field trial committee rule, the harness must be well fitting with nothing hanging from it and with no attachments other than tags for identification purposes and the harness must remain on the dog the entire time the dog is under judgment.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES. Golf carts and utility vehicles may be utilized during the trial. Users of motorized vehicles do so at their own risk, and agree to hold the event club, the property owners and other associated parties harmless from any liability relating to the use of the motorized vehicle. See “allowable drive area” map in the premium list. If a stake is “working North”, the North fence line will be out of bounds, if a stake is “working South”, the South fence line will be out of bounds. If stakes are working towards the Center Line, this may also need to be avoided. Please be aware of which direction the stake is working and do not drive/park carts on the “clean” side.

NOISE. This is a residential area and respect for others in the area is required for use of these grounds. The barking of dogs must be kept under control at all times. For safety reasons (fights, bites, escapes), it is recommended dogs not be left unsupervised in x-pens. “Quiet hours” are from 10:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m. During quiet hours the use of outside lights and noise must be kept to a minimum.

NO SMOKING. Smoking is prohibited on the NIBC and Garard properties, including in the clubhouse, parking/camping areas or on the running grounds.

TRAINING. Training on the grounds is allowed at no charge for those handlers entering the National and/or National Host field trials subject to the rules and dates/times listed below. For those not entering these field trials, training is allowed under the same rules and dates/times for \$20 per day. Training may be suspended by an NIBC owner, if necessary, due to stress on the rabbits, excessive damage to ground cover, failure to abide by running grounds rules, or other conditions deemed to be in the best interest of maintaining the grounds for field trials.

1. One dog at a time loose on the grounds, per handler. Please do not work around this rule by taking someone with you that is not handling their own dog.
2. Dogs must be under the **control** of the handler while on the grounds.
control [kuhn-troh] verb. 1. to exercise restraint or direction over; dominate:command.
3. Handlers will not allow multiple dogs to run together and surround brush piles or “pack hunt”.
4. If any rabbits are caught, killed or injured during training, handlers will report it to an NIBC Owner (Faust, Garard, Gohlke) and donate \$30 to NIBC. The size of the rabbit does not change the fee.
5. The grounds will be closed to training and all handlers and dogs must be off the grounds by 7:30 p.m. each day.

Training on the grounds will be allowed Friday, April 19, 2024 after 12:00 noon, Saturday, April 20, Monday, April 22 and Tuesday, April 23 after the conclusion of the trial for the day, including awards. Training is NOT available Sunday, April 21.

*Handlers with annual running grounds privileges may use the grounds any day the grounds are available for training. This may include breeds other than Dachshunds.

TRACKING COLLARS. The use of tracking collars will not be allowed at these trials.

WALKWAYS. Walkways are marked in the camping areas with white PVC posts. These walkways **must** be kept clear of campers, vehicles, x-pens, tables, chairs, etc. Every occupied camping unit must be accessible by emergency personnel.
