**From I-30 in Greenville, TX to Wolfe City:** Exit Hwy 34 North (exit #93). Follow Hwy 34 (aka Wesley St) thru Greenville (4 miles). Continue to **follow the signs for Hwy 34 through town.** Hwy 34 makes a right turn at O'Neal St near AutoZone & Dollar General. Go 2 blocks and turn left on Johnson St. Cross bridge and continue on Hwy 34 past downtown. At fork in road, veer right for Hwy 34 to Wolfe City/Commerce. After fork, take a left at Phillips 66 (still Hwy 34). Continue north on Hwy 34 for approx. 14.6 miles to Wolfe City. In Wolfe City, Hwy 34 turns left on Santa Fe St. Continue with the directions From Wolfe City.

**From Commerce, TX to Wolfe City:** Take Hwy 11 North. Take the exit ramp for Hwy 11 headed Northwest (turn left). Follow Hwy 11 to Wolfe City. Turn right on Hwy 34 and continue with the directions From Wolfe City.

**From Wolfe City to LSDC:** After leaving Wolfe City, continue on Hwy 34 for approximately 4-5miles Turn left on CR 3355 (white gravel road).
